Just as God spoke to the people of Israel, today he also speaks to us to remind us that we will not win our battles by our strength, but because it is He who is going before us.

Israel's enemies were literal, but what are yours? What do you face that you don't feel ready for? Today we face spiritual enemies, not so clear and literal, but just as intimidating. His promise is that victory is yours, no matter what you face, He goes ahead of you!

Now that we have broken down the verse, what can we learn from this? It may be difficult to see, but God is demonstrating his patience and care for the Israelites. If he drove out the groups of people too quickly, then the Israelites would be outnumbered by the wild animals. That could also put them in danger. He wanted them to increase first, which we will continue to see why in the verses to come.

Many times, we want to take the easy way out of difficult situations, but God wants to walk us through it because he has a bigger plan. He is trying to teach us something in the midst of uncertainty. After all, God is the only one who knows what happens next in our lives.

Today, it can be difficult to trust God and to believe what he says, especially when we don't understand. I encourage you to trust God in this season that you are in. Trust that he knows what he is doing and that all things are working for your good. As we read on, we will see together how this story unfolds and continues to teach us the importance of trusting and obeying God.

# STEP BY STEP (BY SMALL DEGREES OR AMOUNTS)

God is communicating Himself to us, from the standpoint of a Father who guides and provides us with His heavenly plan. He is indicating that little by little, He will indeed fulfill His promises and will continue to reveal His divine intentions for us.

Oftentimes, a short instruction such as this one is needed so we continue to be aware that the Lord is moving. We want our situations to be resolved immediately. It is human nature to want our health restored at the moment of the diagnosis, to want our finances restored at the moment of loss, and to have our petition answered the first time we seek our God. While it is possible for Him to do it in an instant, we repeatedly see that the purpose of waiting is to allow us room to grow intentionally, in His word. As a result, we see in this instance, God promised to do it, step by step.

The enemies will be driven out before us. We will be able to see how God finishes what He has started. It is important to note that He won't do so prematurely, because even the enemies will serve a purpose in our season of conquest. We may be praying that our enemies be taken out, but it is soon revealed the reason they remain, is to fill in while we prepare for full ownership.

God will ensure that our enemies "work" for us, and when the timing is right, when we have grown—both in number and strength—He will release us FULL possession of the land.

The people of Israel receive in that verse a very specific promise - the boundaries of their new nation, and the promise that any opposition that faces them will be "delivered into their hands."

The very specific definition of the area that would be their new land, and home, seems very particular to me. For us, they are just coordinates on a map that delineate a large territory. To them, it perhaps seemed like a fantasy to hear that after being slaves in another great nation (Egypt) they would now become citizens of a greater nation. I wonder if perhaps God used this specific image of their future nation's boundaries to encourage them, that what was to come was much greater than what they had seen or experienced. That Egypt would never compare to the land they would come to possess. That there was nothing to envy anyone, since what would be theirs was separated and protected by God ("because I will put the inhabitants of the earth in your hands, and you will drive them out before you ...").

How many times in our own walk with God have we felt like the best is over, and what lies ahead is not as 'exciting' as what we have already experienced? How many times have we considered our present, and perhaps even our future, and we think "things are not like before ..." or "how I'll miss these times"?. Nostalgia itself is not bad. What's bad is losing sight of the NEW that God is doing. Today I want to remind you that what is new about God includes you too! There is more to see, and more to achieve. His promise is that everything that comes between you and what He has promised will be delivered into your hands. Rest, what is yours, God has already separated it.

# DRAW NEAR TO JEHOVAH ALONE

Why did Jehovah choose only Moses?

### Let's talk about Moses:

There were several times that Moses approached Jehovah alone, and this time in the same way he obeyed God and went up alone to the mountain. What can we see? Jehovah chose Moses, Moses obeyed, Jehovah spoke to Moses and then Moses spoke to the people what God gave him. This is one of several reasons why Moses is considered a type (or symbol) of Jesus Christ. (Heb. 11: 24-26)

### Now, let's talk about Jesus:

He went away to pray, and even though he was equal to the Father, Jesus sought to relate more to him. (Lk. 5: 15-16) Jesus listened to the Father and then did what He told him (Jn. 6:15)

It is evident that the manifestation of power that inhabited Jesus was not only because he was the Son of God, that manifestation was related to his intimacy with his Father.

### Now, let's talk about ourselves:

You and I have been called and even from the womb the need for an intimate relationship with God was inserted into our Soul. Unfortunately in our day to day we are sometimes so burdened and busy in many things, work, home, children, working for God, doing good works that we have inadvertently neglected our intimate life with God. (Rev. 2: 2-4) Our intimacy with God must always be a priority in our lives if we are chosen. (Mt 22:14) And so by giving our work and good deeds to others, everything we give will ALWAYS come directly from God and not from us.

# AS JEHOVAH COMMANDS

I like about this passage that Moses listens to and then repeats verbatim everything that Jehovah had said. It was important that Moses as leader communicate so clearly with the people, since soon he and those called to go up with him would come out from among them and the people would have to follow the guidance of those who would remain in charge.

Imagine if Moses had simply gone up, without communicating, and without ordering things. The people might have thought he had deserted! How important it is as a leader to know how to communicate the instructions that Jehovah gives us. It is important that we be responsible with the messages that God gives us to share with others, as well as those that He gives us ONLY for us. In this case, these instructions were necessary to share with the people so that they too could obey. But, there were also instructions that came later for Moses when he was alone with God that were specifically for him.

Being able to differentiate between what God gives us to share with others, and what he gives us for our ears only, is a matter of the utmost importance. What we say out of time can be a cutting weapon that, instead of bringing blessing, can bring curse.

Every time you hear the voice of God, or feel that he is leading you to do something, test those words by the WORD of God first to confirm that it is really God who is speaking to you. Second, analyze the message that God has given you to see if it is a personal one, or one to share. And if it is to share, inquire in his presence for the precise time to do so. May everything be done as Jehovah commands!

# THE WORDS ARE CARRIED AWAY BY THE WIND

I have heard stories of how many years ago commitments, contracts or agreements were made only by word of mouth. The word was held in very high esteem, what a person agreed or promised to do to fulfill their side of the pact was highly respected. Much of this has changed and sometimes as the saying goes: "words are carried away by the wind"

When we read Exodus 24: 4 we see that after the people of Israel verbally accepted the covenant with God, in verse 3, Moses decides to write everything that God had given him and make an altar to seal the "contract", since these were sealed with sacrifices. Moses does this as if he knew that at the first difficulty the Israelites faced they would forget God's covenant with them and that word of mouth would not be enough. This had to be put in writing, because his words would be blown away ...

Today we have a verbal agreement, a new agreement that is still in force and that is of great value to everyone who confesses it. By declaring Jesus as our Savior, we recognize that only through Him can we obtain freedom and eternal life. A covenant in which we no longer have to raise an altar to make sacrifices because the last sacrifice was made by Jesus on the cross for us. A covenant in which we have the blessing of having his statutes and teachings in writing (his Word from him). This is not seeking that we do not forget what He promised, but rather that while we live under that covenant we also have within our reach what our way of life should be and obtain the benefits that this brings here and now. In this way we are sure that our words will not be carried away by the wind. Hallelujah!

## GOING TOGETHER

The first question that comes to mind: why does Joshua share some of this time with Moses on the mountain?

Uncovering Joshua's story a bit, Joshua was a man of patience, faith, vision, and determination. He was a responsible leader.

God had given Moses the mission to bring the people out of Egypt, but Joshua's mission was to introduce them to the promised land.

We cannot climb the mountain alone. We need a Moses (authority represented), since Moses was under the authority of God and we need the obedience of a Joshua who recognized the authority of Moses.

At some point in our lives (almost always) we need help to climb the mountain.

The word does not let us know that Joshua was on the mountaintop with Moses, so we understand that Joshua knew how to wait for Moses, perhaps at a distance, and he knew how to take care of and respect that unique moment between Moses and God.

We have moments when we cannot carry on alone and need the help, obedience, wisdom and advice of brothers and sisters with the characteristics and virtues of a Joshua.

I invite you to ask for help when you can no longer do it alone and be wise in choosing who goes up to the heights with you and who can respect when God separates you.

# CLOUD JEHOVAH, GOD OF ISRAEL

The cloud symbolizes the special presence of God. Moses went up to the mountain trusting in God that he would be protected and recognizing the assignment. Over the past year I've asked God to fill me with joy and peace (Romans 15:13). The fullness of the Holy Spirit allows us to encounter the Lord with a genuine heart. A heart that does not look past the calling or the gifts deposited within us. Seeking God and his Kingdom first allows us to remain content knowing that everything else will be added. It was important for Moses to be available for the assignment. We need to be available to the calling and be obedient. This will allow us to follow God's path to the "mountain" with the end goal of residing in the center of the cloud. When you're in the presence of God, there is transformation.

We no longer need to go to a literal mountain to be in God's presence. Through our faith in Jesus Christ, we have been gifted the Holy Spirit. Wherever there are two or three believers in his name, there the presence of God is (Matthew 18:20).

Moses as the leader of the people was the man whom God had called to give instructions regarding the people of Israel.

Today, thanks to Christ, we can participate in this invitation or that call to be intimate. 2,000 years ago God changed our scene thanks to the most holy and perfect sacrifice of Christ on the cross and the veil was torn giving us direct access to the Father. (Matthew 27: 50-51) So today we can say that we are the tabernacle where the Holy Spirit (which is the presence of God) dwells.

In these 40 days, God calls us as a church to become intimate, and to enter into his presence. We are believing and praying that just as with Moses, God will be just as intentional with us as a church. The glorious thing about all this is that it is not a call to just one person, but a call to all to enter into intimacy with the Father.

## WILL YOU STAY FAR OR WILL YOU GET CLOSER?

Part of the process of going up the mountain was having an encounter with God.

In this case God is shown as a consuming fire, a fire that can consume anyone who approaches, a frightening fire ...

It is important to understand that when we approach God we must do so with confidence "believing that he is there", not with fear but with great respect. Anyone who wants to get closer to God must be willing to be purified with that consuming fire, and we know that not everyone wants to enter this process.

That fire was so that no one who was not fit would come near, it was a separation of the holy and the unclean (us). Thinking in this way, it is necessary to understand that at some point we all have to face that fire. Like the Israelite people, we also need that "consuming fire". I invite you to present yourself before that fire as a "living sacrifice". It is not about making sacrifices but about being sacrificed, because it is written, "I want mercy, and not sacrifice." It is about sacrificing your dreams, sacrificing your ideas, sacrificing your goals, so that the powerful presence of God lives in us and We can thus be purified and holy for the goal that God has for you.

What are you going to do?
Will you stay looking into the distance?
Will you approach that fire while still risking your own life?

"Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with confidence, that we may obtain mercy and find grace for timely help." Hebrews 4:16

"And he commanded them, saying, You shall do likewise in the fear of the Lord, in truth, and with a whole heart." 2 Chronicles 19: 9

## **COMMUNION**

Today we are going through the 31st day, let us be intentional with the days that remain and even after we have finished these 40 days, because a whole life will not be enough for us to know our Father. How beautiful it is to know that such a magnificent God continually desires to have fellowship with us. His approach to us will always be intentional. Take time today and reflect on what God has allowed you to know about Him and prepare for what you have yet to know.

## 'KORBAN' - GET CLOSER

When you find yourself in the presence of God, you will be able to hear his voice because he will be speaking to you directly.

In the Previous chapter we find that Moses had gone up the mountain to where he spent 40 days and nights with God. During that time God called unto Moses directly, by name, and told Moses what his plans were.

When God speaks to us regarding our calling or the things that He needs to be done, he will let it be known to us by calling us by name. There won't be any doubt about it being His voice. He will call you by your name and His plans will be clear.

On Verse 2 of the scripture we read of what God wanted his people to do . What God needed from the Israelites to build his plan out. This verse shows us that God will ask you to give up something, whether it's items of value or something that is taking your time away from him. He won't pressure you or ever force you to give up something. He will simply ask you. We might not see the big picture of the purpose of that sacrifice but believe that he has a greater plan than what we could ever think of.

A different view of this scripture is that the Hebrew word for 'Sacrificing' is 'Korban' which means "to draw near to".

God wants His People to draw near to Him. When you are With God, there will never be any confusion of what is God's will.

Take this passage today and just pray to draw near to Him. If there is something that is blocking you from him, he will let you know. Offer it up as a sacrifice, and you will see His power no matter what season of your life you are In.

## THE BEST IS FOR HIM

God always speaks clearly to what He requires of His People, because in Him there is no confusion.

In Exodus 25: 1-2 God tells Moses to order his people to bring him an offering and all those who feel the desire to bring it should present it.

God specifically says that it was those who wanted to bring it. In other words, those who felt it in his heart. They were not obliged, or forced. Everything that God asks of his People he wants voluntarily. He never wants to receive anything that comes out of obligation or is forced. Rather, that which comes from a pure and grateful heart from Him.

As with Cain, He will never accept an offering that comes from a tainted heart.

The stones and pieces that Jehovah asked of the People were valuable. Our God is not a God interested in the material, but he is interested in knowing if we are willing to give the best to Him, not simply what we have left over. And most importantly: With what heart we are giving it to Him.

Let's analyze ourselves today, and see if it is necessary to present ourselves to God again, so that He purifies our hearts. So when we present our offering, it is pleasant and acceptable to Jehovah.

## **OUR GUARANTEE**

God asks Moses to collect an offering from among the Israelites. Without giving specific instructions he gives his reason for the collection: "make me a sanctuary to dwell among them." A tabernacle (place of residence, place of dwelling) would be the place of temporary connection between the people and God during their passage through the desert.

God asks for the offering and then gives the instruction, making it clear that the donations of the people should be voluntary and from the heart (v2), and it is that our offering to the Lord must always be with joy and happiness of the best we have, our riches will always be best used when we honor God. And even if it costs us, we are sure that it will be a blessing and for our benefit. As I always tell my family: in God there is never loss, everything is gain.

Although this tabernacle would be temporary, we can keep from this passage a powerful promise from God for our lives. The Israelites would move from place to place in their time through the wilderness, and in the middle of that season they would have challenges, situations, circumstances, and enemies to face as individuals and as a nation. God gives instructions even before beginning that journey to ensure that his presence would be with them, that he would dwell in the midst of his people. The guarantee that they would not cross the desert alone would be very necessary. Read it one more time, they would not cross the desert alone ... What a certainty! You and I have that same guarantee. Even in the midst of our processes and deserts, God is with us. But he is not only there, but he strengthens us and gives us victory. We have that guarantee, Isaiah 41:10, Matthew 28: 19-20 and Romans 8: 37-39.

We are all a unique model that God designed.

It is important that we follow the instructions that God has given us to obtain development, fulfillment, and position in our lives. You are unique. You are what God has shown. God's purpose in our lives is written and designed, we just have to obey and it will be revealed.

#### MEET AT THE MERCY SEAT

The Ark of the Covenant was created so that God's presence could descend and be with his people. He gave such detailed instructions on how to build it. The same way that he was detailed with the Ark, is how God is with us. He created and formed us with such intricacy. Everything about us is exactly how God intentioned it to be. He created us to worship him and established the Ark as a place for his presence to abide. The part where his presence abides is on the mercy seat. The mercy seat is the place God created to meet with you, this is the place where God speaks with you.

In the Old Testament, the high priest would go into the Holy of Holies once a year and present the sacrifice for the people asking for forgiveness. Only the high priest was able to enter and meet with the presence of God. If we move forward into the New Testament, Jesus enters into the story and changes the whole dynamic. With the sacrifice that Jesus made we can now enter into God's presence daily, not just once a year, and we can enter into His presence on our own. We live everyday trying to get closer to his presence. Everyday we must run to the mercy seat.

### BREAD OF LIFE

In the Old Testament, the table of showbread (also known as the table of presence) symbolized God's provision to the twelve tribes (hence the twelve loaves, one for each tribe). In the New Testament, we are again spoken of 'bread' as a symbol of provision, but this time the focus and context change from a literal one, meaning physical bread, to a figurative (metaphorical) context focused on spiritual bread which is Jesus.

In John 6:35, Jesus said, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." (NLT) in verse 51, he said: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

The table of showbread in the tabernacle of Israel was a symbol of the one who would come to fulfill the covenant, the Messiah. Today, you and I are believers under the new covenant - Jesus' sacrifice on the cross paid for our sins and it is no longer necessary to offer sacrifices. Our provision was the life of Jesus himself. We will no longer be thirsty, and we will no longer be hungry because by accepting Jesus as our savior, we accept that he is our eternal sustenance.

If you feel tired, discouraged, spiritually thirsty and hungry today, I present Jesus as your absolute source of sustenance. He is here for you, receive it!
